

SUSSEX COUNTY BOWLS (women's section)  
POINTS SYSTEM FOR GAINING A COUNTY BADGE

**Please note – this does not apply to Competitions where there are less than 16 entries (across the 4 Areas).**

From 2024 – 6 points accrued over 6 years, starting year – 2018.

When enough Points have been accrued, a County Badge will be awarded at a County match during the following season.

The following system applies to **County/National Competitions** that lead to the National Championships at Leamington Spa (does not apply to National Competitions, which are run directly by Bowls England):

Team games i.e. Pairs, Triples, Fours, Senior Fours and Junior Pairs:

Last 16 (last 4 in each Competition Area) - 1 point.

Quarter Finals (last 2 in each Area) - 2 points

County Semi Finals: 3 points

County Finals: 4 Points

County 4-wood Singles

Last 16 – 2 points, Quarter Finals – 3 points, Semi-Finals – 4 Points

Unbadged County Winner – Awarded Badge, runner up – 5 points

County 2-wood Singles and Under 25s Singles

As **team** games above.

For each round won at the National Championship Finals in Leamington – 1 Point.

**Competitions that do not lead to the National Finals:**

Unbadged Singles

Winner Awarded Badge, Runner-up – 5 points,

Semi-finalists – 3 points,

Quarter-finalists – 1 point

Unbadged 'Trixie' Pairs

Winners – 4 points, Runners-up 3 points,

Semi-finalists – 2 points,

Quarter-finalists – 1 point

## Sussex Champion of Champions

Winner – 4 points, Runner-up – 3 points

Semi-finalists – 2 points

Quarter-finalists – 1 point

A player becoming affiliated to Sussex who is a current International may be offered a Sussex County Badge on condition that she plays in at least one County match in her first year of affiliation to Sussex.
