## SUSSEX COUNTY BOWLS - MEN'S SECTION

### BENEVOLENT FUND CONSTITUTION AND REGULATIONS

(amended November, 2028)

1. The Benevolent Fund was awarded Charitable Status in June 1974. It shall be managed by a Committee consisting of four permanent Trustees.
2. Replacement Trustees shall be appointed by that Committee in accordance with the Rules & Regulations of the Charity Commission. The Sussex County Bowls (Men's Section) GPC shall be kept informed of any changes to those Trustees. The Committee shall appoint one of the Trustees to act as Secretary and Treasurer.
3. The Fund to assist poor Sussex Bowlers in need, who are or have been Members of annually subscribing Clubs affiliated to the County Association and poor dependants of deceased Members of such Clubs.
4. Recommendations for assistance to come through the Committees of Clubs and/or through the Trustees.
5. Names of persons receiving assistance are only disclosed to the Committee and Auditors, all cases being otherwise referred to by numbers.
6. A report of the Fund and audited financial statement shall be submitted to the Annual General Meeting of the Sussex County Bowls (Men's Section) and be published in the Sussex County Bowls website.
7. The Financial Year to coincide with that of the Sussex County Bowls (Men's Section).

The object of the Fund is to help all who are poor and in need of assistance and this can be made possible if each Club will contribute annually to the Fund.

In addition, the Committee will appreciate any Competition, Bowls Drives etc. that the Clubs may care to arrange in aid of the Fund.

The Committee appeals to the Clubs and their Member for all possible support of the Fund. Contributions should be sent to reach the Hon. Treasurer Mark Broadway, 18 Oaklee, Compton Road, Lindfield, W Sussex, RH16 2PF before 30 September for inclusion in the accounts for that year.
